A Bibliography of Resource Documents



The NCCE bibliography is a knowledge database resource that provides research-based accountability for NCCE Career Exploration Program content and operations. The bibliography is maintained and regularly updated on the NCCE website for public access and consists of web-based content from universities, industry, public and private education institutions, government and association resources at federal, state, and local levels. Articles from newspapers, magazines and newsletters pertaining to career exploration and career literacy are also reviewed and categorized in the bibliography. NCCE places the highest value on the credibility and accountability of the programs and activities that parents and youth rely on to build career literacy in fulfillment of the NCCE mission.

Currently consisting of approximately 200 resource documents relating to the need for and benefits of career exploration interventions in school-aged youth, the bibliography is compiled from the NCCE knowledge database to identify best-practice information and current intervention practices and outcomes from federal, state, and local levels of government agencies, public school administrations and professional associations supporting career education programs and career education interventions. The need for and benefits of career exploration programs serving youth, parents and the community are recognized over a broad range of sources cataloged in the NCCE knowledge database.

Future Career Exploration programs and activities developed and administered by the National Center for Career Exploration will be supported by findings contained in the NCCE research bibliography. An abbreviated summary of the bibliography follows illustrating the need for kindergarten-through-high school career exploration programs, and the benefits that all community stakeholders gain when youth are empowered to make an informed career path decision.

The following twenty references present research findings from the NCCE bibliography that document benefits of career exploration programs to youth, parents, and the community and form in part the framework of NCCE's strategic visionary goals. 1. The key to changing youth and young adults' perceptions of careers will be mechanisms that assist parents, schools, and community stakeholders to provide learning experiences that communicate the positive opportunities local employment can offer.
2. The more the experience involves actual interaction in the workplace, the more the youth learns about the reality of what an occupation involves and how their personal skills and aptitudes would match a specific job.
3. Parents play key roles in youth's career decision-making process. Parents need help recognizing that youth look to them to provide learning experiences and are greatly influenced by parental occupational advice.

4. Many parents could benefit from educational interventions that expand their knowledge of potential career options that are available to their children in the area and nationally.

1. There is a consensus in the literature that career development is a life long process that begins as early as four years old.
2. Scientists agree that parents are the single most influential factor in the career development and choice of their children but are not adequately informed about how to help.
3. Parents who encouraged their children to think independently and encouraged career exploration tended to have children who participated in much more career exploration than parents who did not implement these strategies.
4. Career decision-making skills have been linked to early childhood experiences, family attitudes and practices regarding careers, and role modeling by mothers and fathers.

5. Despite the plethora of evidence showing parents as the primary influence of their children's career development, parents often do not have the tools or information they need to use their power most effectively.
6. Although parents feel they are actively involved in their children's career decision making, they also feel that they are uninformed about the process and unable to provide competent help.
7. Parents need to know how to best utilize career information, how to assist in the exploration and development of interests and abilities, and how to challenge the sexual and racial stereotypes facing their children. (McNair and Brown 1983).

1. Research suggests that students who drop out of school at age 16 have psychologically disengaged from school as early as Grade 3 (McWhirter, McWhirter, McWhirter, & McWhirter, 1998).
2. Moreover, sixth-through-ninth-grade children have demonstrated very little understanding of how school relates to the real world and seem to have little to no awareness of the skills and knowledge needed for success in the future (Johnson, 2000).
3. Developmentally based career education programs that foster an exploratory attitude in children and promote the exploration of new domains and ideas can broaden children's informational knowledge and exposure to diverse occupations.
4. Early career interventions provide the ideal venue for the promotion of social action initiatives aimed at improving academic achievement and expanding future career options for all students.

1. Occupational aspirations develop during the preschool through college years, particularly between the ages of 9 to 13 (grades 4 through 6) when children develop an orientation to social valuation.
2. Early educational and occupational aspirations are likely influenced by inaccurate perceptions of vocational preparation requirements, and the accuracy of these perceptions does not appear to change markedly as children mature.
3. The need for such formal, systematic career education efforts is particularly apparent in light of Walls' (2000) finding that students' ability to assess vocational preparation requirements did not improve significantly between elementary school and the senior year of high school.

1. Research shows a stark disconnect between the courses of study students pursue and existing career openings and business needs.
2. Educators have seen relatively low (student) interest in technology programs despite continuing demand for techno-logically adept graduates and high income potential for those who choose high-tech careers.
3. Students perceive a lack of career guidance in their schools, and often cannot name anyone outside of their parents who have been helpful in career counseling. Furthermore, most admit that parental guidance has been limited to a few hours in the past few months.
4. The bias toward pursuing a degree from a four-year college is pervasive. More than two-thirds of American young people plan to pursue a four-year college education, despite the fact that far fewer will succeed in this endeavor and that fields requiring only technical training are in need of employees.
5. Ferris State University administered interviews with 809 currently enrolled high-school juniors and seniors from across the United States. The most striking finding of the study?
 - A. Most young people are receiving little to no career guidance outside the home, and not enough from their parents.
 - B. Just 10 percent said school personnel had played the primary role in their career guidance—the vast majority (78 percent) credited their parents as the top adult influence.

2. In order to help students "...acquire the skills to investigate the world of work in relation to knowledge of self and to make informed career decisions" (ASCA National Model Career Development Standard A, 2003, p.83), providing elementary students with career information is essential.

1. Career development is vitally important for today’s youth, who are more than ever “motivated but directionless”.

2. Young people have high ambitions, expecting to be highly educated and have professional careers, yet research has found that many do not develop coherent plans for achieving their goals.
3. Almost two-thirds of high school graduates enter postsecondary education immediately after high school; yet more than a third of those leave within two years without earning any degree.
4. By and large, treatments positively influenced subjects' career decision-making, understanding of careers and career-related adjustment. They also found that the type of intervention contributes to outcomes.
 - A. Guidance activities directed at junior high school students had the largest effect sizes, indicating that guidance efforts may be most effective with pre-teenage (rather than high school or college) students.
 - B. Individual counseling was most effective in terms of its cost-per-hour but that when the cost of a counselor's time is taken into account, the most cost-effective type of intervention is a small-group workshop.
 - C. Career interventions have the most impact on the development of career decision-making skills, as compared to other possible outcomes (such as career-related knowledge or career-related self-concept development).

1. The success of school-to-career (STC) initiatives hinge upon partnerships. Two key ingredients of STC programs – paid work experience and work-based learning – can only be accomplished by involving the business and nonprofit communities.
2. Other aspects of STC (e.g. integrated curriculum and alternative assessment), will not achieve their full potential without active involvement and support from education, business, labor, and parents.
3. It is worth noting that the rate of return enjoyed by an organization appears to be directly related to its level of investment.
4. While students are clearly experiencing positive educational and developmental gains through a challenging integrated curriculum, work-based learning experiences, increased access to adults and mentors, and improved communication with parents, the effects of participation in STC appear to extend beyond the success of students.

1. 94.1 percent of parents with a high school diploma and 98.1 percent of parents with a college degree expect their children to graduate college. This, in spite of the fact that only 20% of today's jobs require a college degree. This disconnect between perception and reality may further exacerbate the problem.
2. The U.S. Department of Labor estimates the typical person will change careers six times during his or her lifetime. What this indicates is the need for a workforce that does not have one specific set of skills, but the ability to learn new skills as technology evolves into a greater part of our everyday lives.

1. In a recent Gallop survey in the U.S. seven in ten adults (69%) report that if they were starting their careers over they would try to get more information about job and career options than they got when they began their working lives.
2. In the same survey more than five times as many people indicated that they entered the workforce by chance rather than by a choice influenced by a career development professional.
3. Many people eventually find their way to satisfying and fulfilling work roles, but too many do not. Those who feel trapped in inadequate work roles are less productive than their satisfied counterparts.

1. Most of us acquired a superficial and narrow knowledge base of occupations while we were growing up. Our occupational knowledge reflected what we knew about our family members' jobs, the jobs of our neighbors, and the people we came in contact with in our community on a regular basis. This natural occurrence tends to severely limit the career options that students see for themselves. It may explain why so many children mention the jobs of firefighter, police officer, nurse, or teacher when asked what they want to be when they grow up.
